Dear Parents & Guardians,

The Eagle Team would like to welcome you and your child to the seventh grade! We know that many students are nervous about having a new team of teachers and new expectations. Also, the team is aware of the important role that parents play in a child's education, and we encourage you to become an active member of our learning team. Many of the activities and assignments will not be successful this year without your help. Please read the following expectations for success with your child and feel free to contact any of us with questions or concerns. Specific classroom expectations will be provided the first day of school.

KEYS TO SUCCESS:

- √Student attendance is critical!
- √Teachers are available before school, after school, and during team time if a student needs support.
- √Students are required to use the agenda book to record assignments and announcements.
- √Parents should check the agenda book to verify assignments.
- √Parents should check PowerSchool and download the app to monitor grades, due dates, and assignments.
- √Parents should be able to login and check the Google Classroom using their child's email address.
- √Students should leave electronic devices in their lockers and turned off – they are a distraction.

HOMEWORK:

- √Student attendance is critical!
- √Homework may be graded for completion or accuracy.
- √Homework should be neat, legible, and turned in on time. Late homework does not receive full credit.
- √Homework copied from another student will result in a zero for each student involved.
- √Students must click "submit" or "turn in" for assignments on the Google Classroom.
- √Students should not email teachers after school about daily homework. Teachers may not be able to respond.
- √Parents should discuss grades and assignments with their child before contacting the teacher.

MAKE-UP POLICY:

- √Student attendance is critical!
- √Until the assignment is completed, a zero will be entered into PowerSchool as a reminder.
- √Each student will be given as many days as he or she missed to make up any assignment.
- √If a student is present at school but absent from class (nurse, restroom, music rehearsal, etc.), he or she is still responsible for all work assigned and collected that day.
- √It is the *student's responsibility* to see the teacher concerning make-up work.
