A nice feature of Schoology is that a full history is there of anything ever posted so scrolling back in time is possible.
- IF ever stops using Smore there WILL BE an official announcement/notice; but foreseeable future will continue with both. Smore is the go-to spot as links and flyers and extras can be included. Schoology is more bare-bones, it will have any pertinent items but flyers become embedded and not readily seen so it is more complicated/less friendly for ease of skimming info. MAYBE in a few years Schoology could replace Dashboard but a transition period of full use of features needs to happen first.

Council Delegate Notes, 9/7/22 HES

- Treasurer's Report
 - No changes from previously presented budget in May; budget was approved
- Executive Board Reports
 - PTA Presidents should have received logins and a request to update their websites from council
 - Membership drives should be be under way

- Reminder for PTAs to pay their dues to the state PTA to be in good standing for the Reflections program
- Friday (9/9) is the elementary president's meeting and 9/20 is the secondary president's meeting; President's coffee is 9/26
- Technology update: all parents should have Schoology access; may want to make sure parents have it
- Need for Council Committee Chairs blurb will be sent out to include in newsletters
 - Current need of Arts Chair, Parent Education and Community Service
 - The most pressing need is for an Arts Chair at the Council level
 - Reflections deadline is 10/17
 - If there is no chair our HS projects will all move on (they are not judged) but MS and Elementary may not be allowed at levels outside of our district due to lack of collective judging
 - The Chair judges HS and arranges the judges for the MS and Elementary level
 - Time commitment is around 2 days and everything is electronic; number of judges are depending on number of submissions and unit level chairs can be Council chair

• Dr. Steinhauer's Report

- Addressed his retiring at the end of the school year
- Mary Beth Irvin spoke on elementary Schoology implementation; the new ELA program; 1 to 1 tech program ad DEI initiatives
- Ron Davis:
 - Schoology
 - Selected by teacher committee after a number of programs were reviewed including Google classroom
 - 2 reasons Schoology was selected: seamless transfer on grading programs and transferability to PowerSchool
 - District understands there may be growing pains but feel that the program will eventually run smoothly as it is used more
 - Addressed the new PA Science Standards and has said the district is already working on this to be ready by the required 2025 implementation deadline
 - Act 158 Pathways (grad competencies) are also being implemented and a presentation will be made in November to the school board
 - Alumni Surveys are reviewed and focus will be on Language Arts, PE, leadership and public speaking improvements

• General Business:

- · New Environmental Chair was introduced
- · Audit Review of last year's Council budget and accounting was presented
- Reminder of Band Festival this coming weekend
- Melissa Berdyk is the new School Board member and has started
- Fire Department
 - Fire safety programs have started in the schools
 - Changes to curriculum at elementary level to clarify Stop, Drop and Roll
 - All school inspections have been completed for the school year and all passed
 - Citizen's Fire Academy applications due

 - New Director has been hired and has started
 - Gave a presentation at the HS orientations
